New Buildings for 2026

Earlier this week, I announced that our school has been approved for some additional learning spaces in preparation for 2026. This will ensure our students can continue to access our quality specialist programs into the future.

Library Books

All library books that are currently on loan to students must be returned to the school by the end of term 3. Please make sure you locate your child's library book and return ASAP so that we can complete our end of term audit and have the library ready to go at the start of term 4. Students who do not return their library books or who have misplaced them will be invoiced for the cost of a replacement book. This ensures that our library remains fully stocked and that books are always available to our students.

Student Attendance

It is important that your child is at school on time, every day to ensure they have the necessary skills, knowledge and learner dispositions which will set them up for secondary school and beyond. Some think that it is secondary school that is most important, but did you know, primary education forms the basis of development. It is in primary school that children learn foundational skills that prepare them for life, work and active citizenship. Quality education empowers children and young people, safeguards their health and well-being, and breaks cycles of poverty.

If you are planning a family holiday, we ask that you consider the timing of this and, if possible, book this one or two weeks either side of the school holidays so that your child is not missing out on important learning and social skills. 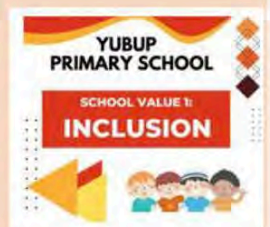
What Inclusion Looks Like at Yubup

Inclusion means inviting everyone to join in, using kind words, and standing up for others. It's about showing respect and being a good friend so that everyone feels like they belong at school.

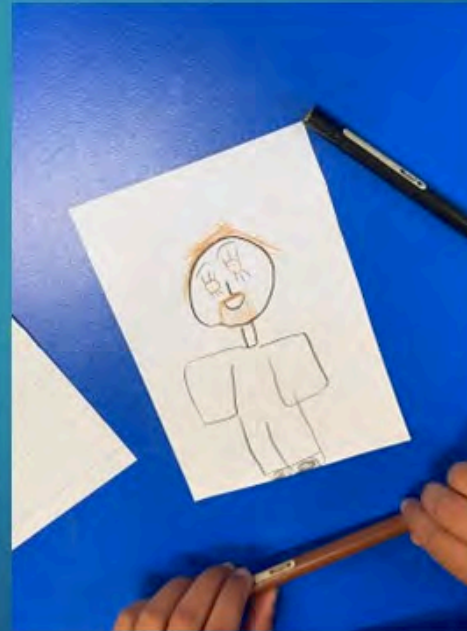
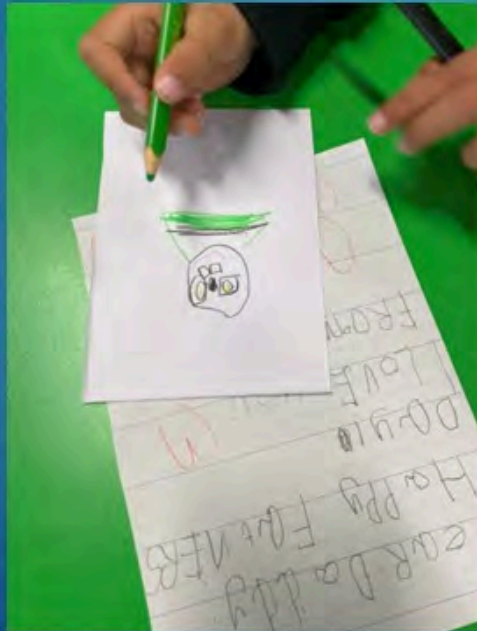

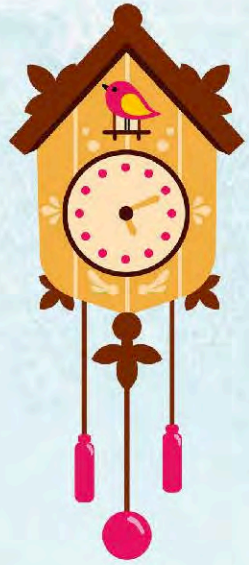
Robots Coming to Life!

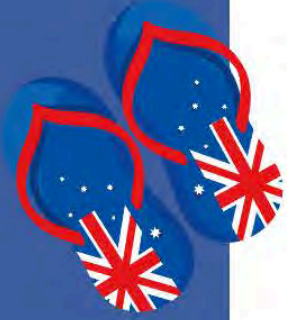

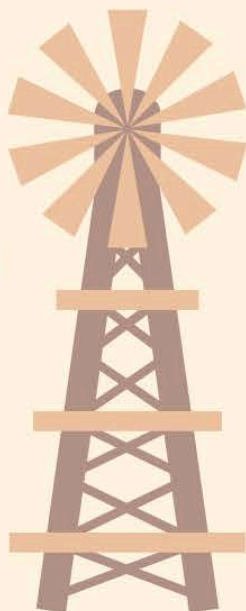
