#### Social Media Ban from the 10th of December

From the 10<sup>th</sup> December 2025, the Online Safety Amendment (Social Media Minimum Age) Act 2024 will require social media platforms to:

- prevent children and young people under 16 from having a social media account.
- deactivate or freeze existing accounts held by people under 16.

Delaying access to social media protects the health and wellbeing of young people and gives them extra time to build real world connections and digital literacy skills. The responsibility will be on the social media platforms, not parents, carers, children or schools; to implement these new restrictions. Most popular social media platforms will be age restricted. These include Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok, X (formerly Twitter), Reddit and YouTube.

Messaging services and online games, as well as apps and platforms that support health and education, can still be used.

#### **End of Year Arrangements**

A reminder to all families that the last day of formal classes for students will be Wednesday  $17^{th}$  of December. The day will conclude with the F – 2 Christmas Concert which will run from 5pm – 7.30pm that night.

Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> of December is a staff clean-up day, and TeamKids will be open for any families who may like to use this service on this day.

Friday 19<sup>th</sup> of December is our last student free curriculum day for the 2025 school year.


### IN 2D THIS WEEK...



# What's happening in Art?

## **Year 1/2**

Year 1/2 students are learning about Dreamtime stories, symbols and colours used by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples to create their own meaningful artworks.





Year 3/4 students are designing personal totems that reflect their understanding of colours, symbols and patterns, followed by artworks inspired by Indigenous representations of people, landscapes and animals.

















# What's happening in Art? Year 5/6

Year 5/6 students are creating totems that reflect their understanding of Aboriginal symbols, patterns, people, places, animals and colour choices, before starting a personal art project of their choice. Students will choose their own materials and techniques to express their understanding of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander culture, people, places and stories.







