## **Social Media Ban from the 10<sup>th</sup> of December**

From the 10<sup>th</sup> December 2025, the Online Safety Amendment (Social Media Minimum Age) Act 2024 will require social media platforms to:

- prevent children and young people under 16 from having a social media account.
- deactivate or freeze existing accounts held by people under 16.

Delaying access to social media protects the health and wellbeing of young people and gives them extra time to build real world connections and digital literacy skills.

The responsibility will be on the social media platforms, not parents, carers, children or schools; to implement these new restrictions. Most popular social media platforms will be age restricted. These include Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok, X (formerly Twitter), Reddit and YouTube.

Messaging services and online games, as well as apps and platforms that support health and education, can still be used.

If you are unable to pick up your child on time afterschool, please make alternate arrangements.


Team Kids is available for before and after school care bookings if you require.

### KINDNESS

#### Kindness at the Busy End of the Year:

As we head into the final weeks of school, the excitement (and fatigue!) can make emotions run high for children and adults. This is a wonderful time to pause and intentionally nurture kindness, patience and empathy at home and at school.

#### Why It Matters:

When routines shift and energy dips, children can become more reactive. Teaching and modelling kindness gives them:

- Strategies to manage stress
- Stronger friendships
- A calmer transition into the holidays
- A sense of belonging and safety

#### Simple Ways to Support Kindness at Home, Practise “Pause and Breathe” moments.

A quick pause helps children respond rather than react when they feel overwhelmed.

Use gentle language prompts

“Try that again with kinder words.”

“How do you think they felt when that happened?”

“Let’s find a respectful solution.”

Catch the positives

Notice and name kind actions: “I saw you helped your sister pack her bag—great teamwork.”

Keep expectations consistent

Clear, calm routines help children feel secure during the busy season.

#### Kindness at Yubup Primary School

At Yubup PS, kindness is part of who we are. Like the parakeet—vibrant, social and connected—our students are learning that small acts of empathy and patience make our community stronger.


# WEEK 9 IN 5/6E MELBOURNE ZOO
